Degree Type	Duration	Total Cost (Approximate)
Associate	2 years	\$6,000 to \$30,000
Bachelor's Degree	4 years	\$40,000 to \$240,000
Master's Degree	1-2 years	\$20,000 to \$120,000
Doctorate (PhD)	4-6 years	Often funded, but can be \$80,000 to \$150,000
Professional Doctorate	3-4 years	\$80,000 to \$300,000

CERTIFICATIONS & COST

- Application Deadlines: Make sure to apply early to secure your grant before the deadline.
 Missing the deadline can result in the loss of financial support.
